

Team NB

To be named to Team NB, teams must enter and compete at the Atlantic Regional Synchronized Skating Championships and qualify for the Skate Canada Synchronized Skating Championships.

Skate Canada Synchronized Skating Championships qualification criteria

To be selected to compete at the Skate Canada Synchronized Skating Championships, a team must place 1st at the Atlantic Regional Synchronized Skating Championships in the Novice, Intermediate, Open, Junior or Senior category as it is stated in the Skate Canada Entry Quota, which states the following:

SELECTION OF ENTRIES FROM REGIONALS

Qualifying Competition Handbook – [620 \(14\)](#):

Selection of entries from Regional Synchronized Skating Championships to Synchronized Nationals Qualifying Rounds is as follows:

- a) The final result in each Regional event shall determine the competitors eligible to enter the equivalent National qualifying competition.
- b) **NOVICE, INTERMEDIATE, OPEN, JUNIOR AND SENIOR:** Teams that place 1st in Novice, Intermediate, Open, Junior and Senior categories at Regional qualifying events may be selected to represent the Section in the respective National qualifying competition.
- c) **ADDITIONAL ENTRIES BASED ON REGISTERED ASSOCIATE MEMBERS IN SECTION:** For every 15,000 registered associate members in the Region, an additional team may be entered into each category at the National qualifying event. The number of sustaining members shall be determined by the membership year September 1 to August 31 of the year preceding the National qualifying event.
- d) Teams placing in the top five at the Skate Canada Synchronized Skating Championships will earn their Region an additional entry (or entries) into the respective category at the National qualifying round the following year.

EXCEPTIONS TO CRITERIA RULES:

Injury

The Synchronized Skating Committee will deal with cases of injury that prevent a team from competing on a case-by-case basis. A medical certificate may be required.

Single entry teams

(Novice, Intermediate and Open)

Should a category only have one entry, the team will be given the option to not attend the Regional Championships and will qualify directly to the Synchronized Skating Championships. Single entries will be given the option to skate an exhibition and be assessed/monitored by a full panel of officials.

TEAM JACKETS

Teams representing Skate NB at the Skate Canada Synchronized Skating Championships are entitled to a Skate NB Synchro team jacket.
