## Eligibility

Only those skaters whose names appear on the team registration form as team members/alternates will be allowed to skate. No substitution or addition shall be allowed. The number of allowable alternates on each team is four.

## Competition Entry Fees

\$250 per team and \$20 per skater, including alternates (Teams Skating 2 programs)

\$125 per team and \$15 per skater, including alternates (Teams Skating 1 program)

## PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS

***Planned Program Content sheets must be submitted to the LOC by February 16, 2018 at the latest. There will be a \$20 fee charged for failing to submit Planned program by the deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a Planned Program sheet has been submitted***

## Team Managers and Chaperones

All team managers and chaperones must be current Skate Canada registrants.

Two coaches, one team manager and two chaperones for a total of five people per team will be accredited.

The main coach and one alternate (skater) will stand at the entrance to the ice, and the team manager and other alternates in the exit area. The chaperones will be allowed in the dressing rooms ONLY and will not have access to ice level during practice and competition.

## Event Specification and Eligibility Requirements

The following categories are based on age and number of skaters. Refer to *Skate Canada 2017-2018 Synchronized Skating Technical Requirements*.

### **Teams Skating 1 Program**

Beginner I	8 – 16 skaters	At least 75% of the skaters must not have reached the age of 12 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	Max 2:10 min
Beginner II	8 – 16 skaters	Skaters must not have reached the age of 12 as of July 1st preceding the competition. At least 75% of the skaters must not have reached the age of 10 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	Max 2:40 min
Elementary	8 – 16 skaters	Skaters must not have reached the age of 15 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	Max 2:40 min
Pre-Juvenile	8 – 16 skaters	Skaters must not have reached the age of 12 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	Max 2:40 min
Juvenile	8 – 16 skaters	Skaters must not have reached the age of 15 as of July 1st preceding the competition. At least 75% of the skaters must not have reached the age of 13 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	Max 3:10 min
Pre-Novice	8 – 16 skaters	Skaters must have reached the age of 12 as of July 1st preceding the competition but must not have reached the age of 18 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	Max 3:10 min

Adult SYS Class I	8 – 20 skaters	Skaters must have reached the age of 18 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	Max 3:40 min
Adult SYS Class II	8 – 20 skaters	Skaters must have reached the age of 18 as of July 1st preceding the competition. At least 75% of the skaters must have reached the age of 25 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	Max 3:10 min
Adult SYS Class III	8 – 20 skaters	Skaters must have reached the age of 19 as of July 1st preceding the competition. At least 75% of the skaters must have reached the age of 35 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	Max 2:40 min

## Teams Skating 2 Programs

Event	Team Size	Age Requirements	Program Time
Novice	12 – 16 skaters	Skaters must have reached the age of 10 as of July 1st preceding the competition but must not have reached the age of 15 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	3:30 min +/- 10 sec
Intermediate	12 – 16 skaters	Skaters must have reached the age of 13 but must not have reached the age of 19 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	4:00 min +/- 10 sec
Open	12 – 16 skaters	Skaters must have reached the age of 15 as of July 1st preceding the competition.	4:00 min +/- 10 sec

## Refunds, Exhibitions and Skating Up

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the date of closing of entries. (SC Rule 7000 1.5 (2)).

If only one team is entered in an event, the team has the option to skate an exhibition or withdraw from the competition. The LOC will contact the team manager and the team manager will have 48 hrs to convey their decision back to the LOC and this decision shall be final. If an answer is not received, the event will be cancelled.

Teams wishing to skate an exhibition will be charged the regular skating fee. This fee will include feedback from the judging panel via the ISU report card. No medals are awarded for exhibition skates.

## Schedule

The schedule of events will be made available on the Skate Canada NB website. Electronic mail will also be the primary method of communication with Skaters and Coaches.

**Note that the Technical Representative and the LOC reserve the right to cancel events for reasons of logistical constraints. Any such decision will be communicated accordingly to the membership via email and/or the Skate Canada NB website.**
