## **Eligibility**

Only those skaters whose names appear on the team registration form as team members/alternates will be allowed to skate. No substitution or addition shall be allowed. The number of allowable alternates on each team is four.

## **Competition Entry Fees**

\$250 per team and \$20 per skater, including alternates (Teams Skating 2 programs)

\$125 per team and \$20 per skater, including alternates (Teams Skating 1 program)

## **PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS**

**Planned Program Content sheets and music in MP3 format must be submitted to the LOC by February 8th, 2019 at the latest. There will be a \$20 fee per category charged for failing to submit Planned program and music by the deadline. Teams will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a Planned Program sheet and music have been submitted**

## **Team Managers and Chaperones**

All team managers and chaperones must be current Skate Canada registrants.

Two coaches, one team manager and two chaperones for a total of five people per team will be accredited.

The main coach and one alternate (skater) will stand at the entrance to the ice, and the team manager and other alternates in the exit area. The chaperones will be allowed in the dressing rooms ONLY and will not have access to ice level during practice and competition.

## **Refunds, Exhibitions and Skating Up**

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the date of closing of entries.

If only one team is entered in an event, the team has the option to skate an exhibition or withdraw from the competition. The LOC will contact the team manager and the team manager will have 48 hrs to convey their decision back to the LOC and this decision shall be final. If an answer is not received, the event will be cancelled.

Teams wishing to skate an exhibition will be charged the regular skating fee. This fee will include feedback from the judging panel via the ISU report card. No medals are awarded for exhibition skates.

## **Schedule**

The schedule of events will be made available on the Skate Canada NB website. Electronic mail will also be the primary method of communication with Skaters and Coaches.

**Note that the Technical Representative and the LOC reserve the right to cancel categories for reasons of logistical constraints. Any such decision will be communicated accordingly to the membership via email and/or the Skate Canada NB website.**
