



Skate Canada New Brunswick Provincial STARSkate and ACSC Teams

Skaters will qualify for the Provincial STARSkate and Atlantic Canada Skating Championships (ACSC) at the SCNB Provincial STARSkate Championship.

The top 4 competitors from each of the following singles categories at the SCNB Provincial STARSkate Championship will be named to the 2020 Skate NB STARSkate Team.

- STAR 5 (all age categories)
- STAR 6
- STAR 7
- STAR 8
- STAR 9
- STAR 10
- Gold
- Pre-Juvenile
- Juvenile

The top 4 competitors (under the age of 19 as of July 1st) from each of the following singles categories at the SCNB Provincial STARSkate Championship will qualify for ACSC.

- STAR 5 (all age categories)
- STAR 6
- STAR 7
- STAR 8
- STAR 9
- STAR 10
- Gold
- Pre-Juvenile
- Juvenile

If a skater is unable to attend, skaters will be contacted in their order of placement (starting from fifth place) until a replacement is found or no competitors remain in the category. Only those who attend ACSC will be named to the ACSC team.

Withdrawals from Qualifying Event and Byes

Medical Withdrawal

If a skater must withdraw from the ACSC qualifying event (SCNB Provincial STARSkate Championship) due to a medical issue, and there are no more than 4 competitors registered in the category, the skater may apply for a bye. Applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

To apply the following criteria must be met:

- the skater must be registered at the qualifying event (SCNB Provincial STARSkate Championship) in the category
- the skater must inform the [STARSkate Programs Chair](#), via email, of their request at the latest 48 hours prior to the start of the SCNB Provincial STARSkate Championship.
- the STARSkate Programs Committee will review each case and its decision will be final
- a medical certificate may be required
- the skater must have competed at an earlier event in the current season (e.g. SCNB Winter Skate), and provide the STARSkate Programs Committee with proof (report card)
- there must be no more than 5 competitors registered in the category.
- If the skater's request for a bye is approved, the skater will be able to register to compete at ACSC

Exhibitions at the SCNB Provincial STARSkate Championship

If a skater is the only registrant in their category, they may choose to skate up a category, skate an exhibition, or withdraw. In all cases the skater will qualify to compete at ACSC.

Skating Up

Should the skater choose to skate up a category, they would register at ACSC for the category they had originally registered to compete in at the SCNB Provincial STARSkate Championship.

Skaters registered for STAR 4 may skate up to STAR 5; however, they will not be able to qualify for ACSC.

Alternate Policy

An alternate may be called on to compete up until the Wednesday at midnight preceding the start of ACSC.

Failure to register

In the event a qualifying skater does not register for ACSC by midnight on the day registration is due, the skater will be considered withdrawn. The STARSkate Committee Chair will notify the alternate of the opportunity to compete at ACSC via email.

Withdraw from ACSC

In the event of a skater who has qualified, and registered for ACSC, chooses not to compete for any reason, they must notify the [STARSkate Committee Chair](#) as soon as the decision to not compete has been made. The alternate will be notified of the opportunity to compete at ACSC via email by the STARSkate Committee Chair prior to March 25th, 2020.

Jackets

The 4 skaters in each category that attend ACSC will have the option of purchasing an ACSC Team jacket. Jackets may be ordered at the Provincial STARSkate Championship. SCNB cannot guarantee orders made following the Provincial Championships.
