

CompetitiveSkate Team Criteria

To be named to a Skate Canada New Brunswick CompetitiveSkate Team, the skater(s) must enter and compete in at least one Summer or Fall competition and the SCNB Sectional Championships (Sectionals). This requirement does not apply to the Development Team.

Points awarded under CPC will be utilized to determine qualification for the CompetitiveSkate Team. To count, the points must be from the same category in which the skater competes at Sectionals.

The Team Divisions will be as follows:

- Elite Team – NextGen and skaters competing at the international level.
- High Performance Team – Pre-Novice to Senior
- Competitive Team – Pre-Novice to Senior
- Development Team – Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile, STAR 5 U13

For all categories, technical scores (TES) from Summer and, Fall competitions, Sectionals, Skate Canada Challenge, Skate Canada National Skating Championships and International competitions will be used to determine the eligibility and division of those being considered for a the SCNB CompetitiveSkate Team.

In singles and pairs, the best technical Short Program score will be combined with the best technical Free Program score from the competitions to give a total score.

In dance, the best Free Dance technical score will be used as the total score.

For Juvenile, Pre-Juvenile and STAR 5, the best technical Free Program score will be used as the total score.

Note: Bonuses and Deductions will no longer be considered in the calculation.

ADDITIONAL CRITERIA RULES:

1. Injury

- The Competitive Skating Programs Committee will deal with cases of injury that prevent a skater from competing on a case-by-case basis. A medical certificate may be required.

2. Competing Out of Province

- Skaters may receive permission to compete at another Section's Sectional Championships if there are fewer skaters registered than qualifying positions available for Challenge in an event.
- Skaters must consult with and obtain approval from the Competitive Skating Programs Committee regarding competing out of province **prior** to the registration deadline for Sectionals.
- Following the out of province competition, skaters are responsible for forwarding their report cards to the Competitive Skating Program Committee: competitive@skatenb.org

3. Transferring from Other Sections

- Skaters transferring from other Sections who wish to qualify for the SCNB CompetitiveSkate Team must qualify under the residency rule in place).

4. Yearly Planning Instrument

- Each athlete who meets the points criteria listed above for the SCNB CompetitiveSkate Team must submit a completed yearly planning instrument (YPI) outlining his/her/their plans for the **upcoming** skating season to the Competitive Skating Programs Committee **no later than April 1**, unless specified by SCNB due to extenuating circumstances. In the event a YPI is not submitted, the athlete may be removed from the SCNB CompetitiveSkate Team.

5. Exceptional Circumstances

- The Competitive Skating Programs Committee reserves the right to appoint additional SCNB CompetitiveSkate athletes to Team based on exceptional circumstances.
