



## Own The Jump

In order to provide funding and motivate/reward athletes for technically advanced programs, Skate NB will be providing scholarships for successful jump elements at invitational competitions. The elements must meet the following criteria:

1. Each jump receives an overall 0 GOE or above.
2. The jump(s) must be fully rotated and cannot receive a < or << (under-rotate or downgrade).
3. The triple lutz and/or triple flip cannot receive an “e” (edge).

The chart below indicates the elements that result in a scholarship. Certain elements are not rewarded so as not to encourage including elements beyond the capability of the athlete. Other elements are not included as they should be an accepted part of the skater’s program already.

Own the Jump applies to Skate NB skaters who compete at any summer or fall invitational competition between (June 1 to October 31). A maximum of two competitions, with the best results, will be considered.

Athletes are responsible for submitting a report card to following address to demonstrate successful completion of an element. Scholarships will be disbursed in November.
