

POLICY: Challenge Qualification Policy

REFERENCE:

EFFECTIVE DATE: September 1, 2017

Purpose:

This policy outlines the process by which Skate Canada New Brunswick (SCNB) will select its entries from SCNB Sectionals to Skate Canada Challenge.

Policy:

The top placements from each discipline of Pre-Novice, Novice, Junior, and Senior at Sectionals according to Skate Canada rule 520(10) will qualify for Challenge provided the athlete or team has achieved the Challenge Minimum Score (CMS) defined by Skate Canada.

An athlete or team who does not achieve the CMS at SCNB's Sectionals but places high enough to be considered for SCNB's "Normal Quota Entries" must provide proof of meeting the CMS to the SCNB Executive immediately following Sectionals.

In the event the athlete or team has not achieved the CMS, they will not be selected by SCNB to compete at Challenge.

In the event SCNB has no entries that have met the CMS in a category, SCNB will not select any entry from that category to compete at Challenge.

The SCNB Executive will meet immediately following SCNB Sectionals and apply this policy to determine its entries to Skate Canada Challenge. A public announcement of the entries will be made immediately following this meeting.
